Insulator maker lands \$1.5 million deal

Lapp Insulators LLC has been awarded a three-year, \$1.5 million contract by American Electric Power Co. Inc., the LeRoy, Genesee County, firm announced Tuesday.

The manufacturer of high-voltage porcelain insulators will produce polymer insulators for AEP, an electric utility company based in Columbus, Ohio.

Jim Pries, Lapp product manager, said the contract is proof Lapp will be viable in the insulator industry now and in the future.

Lapp employs some 210 local staffers.
